



Activities Report FY 2019-20

1. Introduction

Deepalaya is a non-profit voluntary organisation established in the year 1991 as a rehabilitation unit offering OPD services to the mentally and physically challenged individuals. The year 1999 marked the legal registration of Deepalaya as a Charitable Society under the **Society Registration Act XXI of 1860**; registration dated: **11-12-1999**.

Deepalaya as a civil society organisation was established to promote voluntary actions at the grass root level, in the field of care and rehabilitation of persons with disability, women empowerment, promotion of women and child rights, employment opportunity for rural and semi urban women.

Deepalaya has rendered its services through promotion of sustainable, equitable and participatory development, social welfare and justice through women empowerment programs, promotion of livelihood among women by SHG formulation, Rehabilitation Center for Person with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation(IDD) and Multiple Disability and contribution to social welfare policy and program at State and National Levels.

2. Key Activities and Achievements

A. Activity 1: Awareness Program on Adolescent and Family Planning

1. **Objective:** To educate adolescents and their families on reproductive health, family planning methods, and the importance of making informed decisions for a healthier future.
2. **Description:** An awareness session was conducted on adolescent health and family planning, covering topics such as puberty, menstrual hygiene, contraception, and responsible decision-making. The interactive session engaged adolescents and parents through discussions, Q&A, and IEC materials. Experts emphasized the significance of open communication within families and access to reliable healthcare services. The program aimed to empower participants with knowledge, reduce stigma, and promote well-being.
3. **Location:** Purnia District (Purnia East Block, Kasba Block, Srinagar Block, Krityanand Nagar block)
4. **Outputs/Achievements:**
 - 49 Community Outreach Workers (Women) reached 7500 households across 3 blocks
 - 21 PRI were trained

B. Activity 2: Short Stay Home, Women Development Corporation Bihar

1. **Objective:** To provide temporary shelter, safety, and rehabilitation support to women in distress, ensuring their well-being and empowerment.
 2. **Description:** The Short Stay Home offers secure accommodation, counselling, legal aid, and vocational training to women facing difficult circumstances, including domestic violence and abandonment. The initiative, supported by the Women Development Corporation Bihar, focuses on rehabilitation and reintegration by equipping beneficiaries with essential life skills and livelihood opportunities. Regular awareness sessions and community linkages strengthen support systems, ensuring long-term empowerment and independence for the women.
 3. **Location:** Purnia District
 4. **Outputs/Achievements:**
 - 900 beneficiaries received both counselling/legal services and Rehabilitation benefit.

C. Activity 3: Anganwadi training Center, ICDS Directorate, Govt. of Bihar

1. **Objective:** To enhance the capacity of Anganwadi workers by providing training on child nutrition, early childhood education, maternal health, and community engagement.
2. **Description:** The Anganwadi Training Center, under the ICDS Directorate, Govt. of Bihar, conducted a structured training program for Anganwadi workers. Sessions covered topics like child growth monitoring, supplementary nutrition, immunization, and early learning methods. Interactive workshops and demonstrations strengthened their practical skills, ensuring effective service delivery at the grassroots level. The training aimed to empower workers with updated knowledge and strategies to improve maternal and child health outcomes in their respective communities.
3. **Output:**
 - 175 Sevika trained under 32 Days Job course Training Program. 5 JOB Course Batches were conducted.

D. Activity 4: Creating Economic Opportunity for Women (NOMI Network Inc.)

1. **Objective:** To equip women from marginalized communities with skills, resources, and market access to achieve economic independence and break cycles of exploitation and poverty.
2. **Output:**
 - 100 Household surveyed and 50 selected for life skill training (Foundation Phase-1).
 - 2 Cohort of 50 beneficiaries each, trained for vocational skills and job oriented roles.
 - **Legal Awareness program for community – 75**
 - **Awareness program on adolescent girl child- 55**
